The Benjamin Franklin Transatlantic Fellows Institute is pleased to announce the availability of small grants for 2016, 2017, and 2018 BFTF Alumni follow-on projects.

The Benjamin Franklin Transatlantic Fellows Summer Institute accepts applications from 2016, 2017, and 2018 BFTF alumni to fund a limited number of follow-on projects. BFTF is able to award grants from \$100 to a maximum of \$500.00 per successful proposal.

BFTF alumni are encouraged to be as detailed as possible in the description of proposed projects, including rationale, goals, appropriate budget, evaluation means, as well as specific time-line for the implementation of the project. We also require that proposed projects benefit your home community/region/country in some significant way.

We evaluate projects based on the overall quality, impact, and feasibility. Prospective applicants are therefore advised to submit proposals that are clearly manageable considering the human and financial resources and constraints. We encourage prospective applicants to find partner agencies to support the cost of implementing the proposed projects. As the BFTF committee, we give special consideration to proposals that make careful use of the requested funds, work with community partners, and secure external funding to augment the BFTF funds.

Grant Amount: \$100.00 to a maximum of \$500.00

Application Deadline: March 1, 2019

Project Specifications: Proposed projects must benefit your home community/region/country in a significant way. You need to present a well-crafted and well-researched argument for your project.

Budget Guidelines: The basic categories for a budget could include items such as the following: facilities (e.g. rental of meeting space); advertising (media, newsletter, etc.); compensation (speakers, teachers); travel/local transportation cost; reception/food; educational material (printing, brochures etc.); et cetera. Appropriate items will vary with each project. Applicants should provide as many budget details as possible.
