Selection Criteria

- (1) Strong academic achievement. Those in the upper quarter of their class will be favored.
- (2) Record of participating in high school or college activities with an emphasis on community civic activities.
- (3) Essay quality. Statement of candidate's interest in transatlantic relations and appreciation of the Ben Franklin program
- (4) Strong letter of recommendation.
- (5) Telephone conversations with Letter of Recommendation writer and/or other two recommenders.
- (6) Telephone or Skype interview with Semi-Finalists. Selection panel members will have a 10-15 minute conversation further exploring the candidate's reasons for joining the program.
- (6) Committee will consider geographical, ethnic and socio-economic factors to ensure balanced representation.
